ROUTINE SCREENINGS	SDoH ¹ (Social Determinants of Health) identifies nonmedical factors that influence health outcomes.	MCHAT ⁸ (Modified Checklist for Autism in Toddlers) is an autism risk screening tool.
	First Tooth ² is an oral health risk assesment (starting at 9 months old.)	ASQ ⁹ (Ages & Stages Questionnaire) is a developmental screening tool. <i>*now available electronically</i>
	NBS ³ (Newborn Screening) is a blood test to identify rare diseases.	BP ¹⁰ is a measurement of blood pressure.
	EPDS ⁴ (Edinburgh Postnatal Depression) identifies postnatal depression & anxiety in parents.	Vision Screen ¹¹ identifies distance vision concerns.
	ACES ⁵ identifies parental risk and protective factors based on life experiences.	CRAFFT ¹² identifies substance use in adolescents.
	LEAD ⁶ is a blood test to check lead levels.	PHQ-9 ¹³ (Patient Health Questionnaire) identifies major depressive disorder (MDD) in adolescents.
	H&H ⁷ is a blood test to check for anemia.	asQ ¹⁴ (ask Suicide Screening Questions) identifies suicide risk in adolescents.
